- Determinants: Epidemiology and environmental health, Epidemiology and climate change, Epidemiology and nutrition, Epidemiology and behaviours
- Methods: Epidemiology and big/open data, Methods in epidemiology, Epidemiology biostatistics and modelling, Surveillance, Spatial epidemiology

## Presenting Author Responsibilities

The person submitting the abstract identifies the author who will be designated as the presenting author. The Presenting author will be the primary contact for the abstract. He will be responsible to communicate to all co-authors regarding acceptance of the abstract and to obtain conflict of interest disclosures from the co-authors. Please note that, the Presenting author have to be register to the congress in order to present his abstract.



## Abstract Format and Submission

In order to submit your abstract, use the platform accessible on the website <http://www.euroepi2018.com/call-for-abstracts> and follow the steps.

- Following items are required:
  - Authors Information
  - Preferred Abstract Presentation Format (oral, poster) - Final decision will be made by the Scientific Committee
  - Abstract title in uppercase. Title should contain no more than 250 characters
  - Abstract Topic (select theme that best describe your abstract)
  - Abstract Body should be structured: Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusions
- Abstract should be no more than 4000 characters (550 to 600 words) and do not include figures or tables
- The official language of the Congress is English and there will be no translation services provided during the congress
- Abstract should contain results. Abstract with "results to be discussed" will not be accepted
- Abbreviations should be introduced before use. For example, "hepatitis C virus (HCV)."
- Abstract must be original and must not have been published or presented at any other conference prior to this congress
- Abstracts must be submitted via the online platform only

## Abstract Review & Acceptance

All presentations will be accepted based on quality, relevance and space availability after review by the Scientific Committee.
